Manager comment

In the 3d quarter interest rate expectations were key factors influencing market performance driving valuations higher.

The 4th quarter 2025 market perspectives show a mixed outlook with US stock valuations fully priced in, while Europe and Emerging markets show opportunities in targeted sectors. The US economy faces slowing growth and persistent inflation, with potential headwinds from fading stimulus and tariffs, yet it is supported by strong innovation and corporate earning uplift.

The Global economy is experiencing slowing growth. However, AI investment and monetary policy easing are providing support. Sticky inflation, fueled by tariffs, continues to be a challenge worldwide. We think that future stock performance will largely depend on corporate earnings growth. Therefore, we are maintaining a resilient portfolio focusing on undervalued themes such as Healthcare, value stocks such as Global income and Dividend stocks with diversification through options like physical metals (gold).

Long term we stay positive about markets with the key to long-term returns be transformational innovation as a vital driver of potential outperformance.

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Fund summary

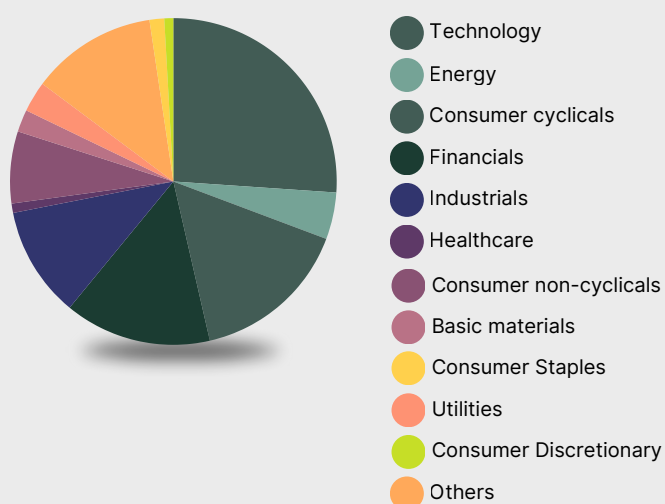

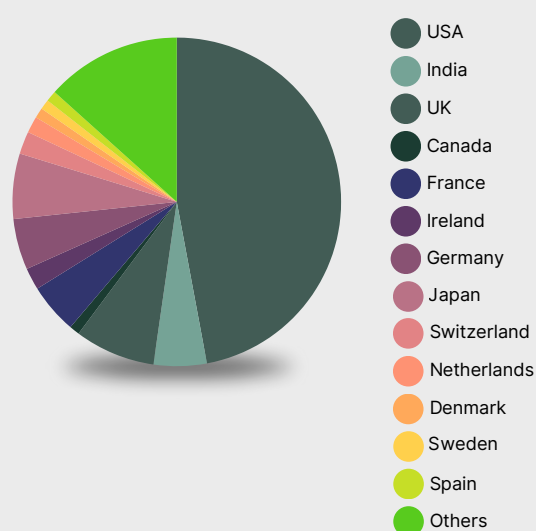
